



Friday, November 19 - South to Wild Horse Desert & King's Inn for a pre-Thanksgiving celebration.

The advice is "Go West," but we're going south seeking history, legend, mystery and adventure on the storied Wild Horse Desert. In the early 1800's it really was a desert and large herds of mustangs ran wild. After coffee enroute to <u>Jourdanton</u> we'll enter the Wild Horse desert and explore the many historic markers in <u>Tilden</u>. Of special interest is "Boot Hill Cemetery" so called because so many of those buried there died violently "with their boots on" in this lawless town first named "Dog Town." It was reputed to be a lawless and bandit-filled place.

The reward for this excursion into Texas History is lunch at Kings Inn where experienced Holloway Tourists know we'll enjoy the Family Feast of Fish, Shrimp, Frog Legs, Oysters, French Fries and Onion Rings – all fried, of course – preceded by beautiful slices of Ric Grande Valley Avocado and Tomatoes. King's Inn is located near Riviera (pronounced "Raveera" here) where we will hear the story of misbegotten dreams of a world famous resort. There are still palm lined streets to lend credence.
