THE LANDSCAPE HAS SHIFTED

Last week the Rio Texas Conference of the UMC held its Annual Conference meeting in Corpus Christi, TX. A number of Laurel Heights UMC Clergy and Laity attended, including Reverend Lisa Straus, Reverend Laura Healy, Reverend Tanya Campen, Reverend Wesley Craig, Byrd Bonner, Jason Davis, Melinda Hartson, Bill Myers, Kaci Boylan, Mary Howard, and Karen Angelini. Annual Conference is not only where the business of the church gets done, but also where hundreds of church representatives gather to participate in worship, prayer, communion, and teaching sessions. This year the teaching sessions were led by UMC Pastor Blair Thompson White. Here are a few of her observations about where we are today as a church.

In years past, Americans embraced affiliation, convergence, the "we" culture, and broadcast experiences. In other words, Americans wanted to belong to organizations; we wanted to have relationships; and we wanted to "sit and get". The church met those expectations, so in 1999, 70% of Americans belonged to a religious institution. *But the landscape has shifted!* Today Americans embrace individualism, divergence, the "I" culture, and interactive experiences. So, by 2020, only 47% of Americans belonged to a religious institution.

It does not serve us well to rely on past patterns of success. The churches that thrive today are asking what the spiritual needs of people today are and determining how to meet those spiritual needs. The churches that thrive today are asking why we are doing what we're doing and looking for more innovative ways to be the church. The churches that thrive today are asking what God's dreams are for their churches and determining what are the next steps to making those dreams a reality. Focusing on God's dreams for the church results in people wanting to be a part of that.

Pastor Blair told a story about the disciples becoming overwhelmed and telling Jesus they needed more Jesuses to do God's work in the world. Jesus told the disciples to pray for more Jesuses. They did, and Jesus told them their prayers were answered. He pointed to them and said, "**You** are the Jesuses!"

In order for our churches to thrive we need more Jesuses!




