Walk to Emmaus at Laurel Heights UMC

Sunday (August 20), I talked to both Laurel Heights United Methodist Church worship services about upcoming Walks to Emmaus and reviving the Emmaus Community at Laurel Heights UMC. What a joy to see many hands raised when I asked how many have completed a Walk!

First a little Walk to Emmaus background. As related in the Gospel of Luke Chapter 24 verses 13-35, there were two disciples of Jesus walking along the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus sharing their deepest concerns about the death of Jesus. An unknown person joined them and explained the scriptures as they walked. When they arrived at home, toward the end of the day, they asked the stranger to stay and eat with them. As the stranger took bread, blessed, broke, and shared it with them, their eyes were opened, and they recognized the risen Christ! Jesus vanished from their sight, and they rushed back to Jerusalem to share the good news with the other disciples.

The Walk to Emmaus is an experience of Christian renewal beginning with a three-day short course in Christianity. It is an opportunity to meet Jesus Christ in a new way, as God's grace and love are revealed through other believers.

The objective is to inspire, challenge, and equip church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, and places of work. The Walk to Emmaus lifts up ways for our grace-filled lives to be lived and shared with others.

About twenty-five years ago a friend talked about the Walk to Emmaus and concluded saying, "You owe it to yourself to attend a Walk to Emmaus." When he finished, I turned to my wife, Carolyn, and said, "I think I can do that." A few years later the opportunity to attend came up and I reluctantly went to Mount Wesley, in Kerrville, Texas. I was so reluctant, I took our then new cellphone, loaded up with 30 minutes talk time a month, and told Carolyn if it wasn't right I would call her to come rescue me! I never made that call. As a recovering heathen, it was the best thing I've ever done for me spiritually because I learned that by God's Grace and at the cost of Jesus Christ on the Cross my sins are forgiven.

Due to restrictions begun during the recent Covid-19 pandemic, Emmaus Walks and Community meetings have not occurred and it is time for a new beginning! The Care Bexar Emmaus Community is sponsoring Men's Walk to Emmaus #125 at Mount Wesley in Kerrville, September 14-17, 2023. I have Walk applications and brochures explain the Walk to Emmaus in detail.

The Care Bexar Community is sponsoring Women's Walk #126, at Camp Capers near Comfort, Texas, April 25-28, 2024. They are preparing the Walk application now.

A very important aspect of the Walk application process is every applicant must have a sponsor, who has completed a Walk, to assist them with the application process and if you want to go and don't have a sponsor, ask me—I'll help you find the right person! They may be sitting next to you in worship.

Part two! Many of you know retired Pastor Jon Lowry who has served here at Laurel Heights UMC as senior pastor and now attends and sings in the Choir during the 11 o'clock service. When Carolyn and I began attending Worship here a few weeks ago, Pastor Jon suggested a need to reestablish regular Emmaus Worship here at Laurel Heights UMC. I believe with God's help and some participation all things are possible. A reminder, Emmaus Community meetings are not a secret society! They are open to all for eating, singing and praising our Lord and Savior Jesus the Christ!

Finally, no matter where you are in your faith journey, the Walk to Emmaus will take you further. De Colores!






