I mentioned how I loved kids and babysitting, which I had been doing since my little brother, Asher, was born. Lee Ann asked me if I wanted to work in Godly Play with her, which happened concurrently with service. I said yes, mostly because I wouldn't have to sit in that pew.

But what I didn't know was that God sent Lee Ann to help me reconnect with him. By working in Godly Play, I started to form relationships with the church's kids and their families, and I began to feel at home in my new church and reconnect with God. I volunteered in Godly Play with Lee Ann until I moved away for college. Going into my freshman year, I knew working with kids was my spiritual gift. When I first came to Laurel Heights, the first question I asked was if Godly Play needed help teaching kids. I began working in Godly Play that next Sunday.

I love my Godly Play class. When I was homesick last year, adjusting to college, I knew the Godly Play room here was somewhere I belonged. Just last week, I walked into the fellowship hall, and Mia, one of our kids, ran up to me with this huge smile and gave me a hug. Another one of my kids, Wyatt and I both love Pokemon, and he always brings his Pokemon toys to show me during work time. Children never fail to make me smile and remind me of the joy God brings to our lives. Not only do I have the opportunity to teach our kids about God, but I get to be a role model for them on how to live as a Christian. I am so grateful God blessed me with the spiritual gift of working with children, and I wouldn't change it for anything else.


