

The Journey

Introductory Dinner January 7: We will begin the journey by sharing an evening meal and guided conversation together.


Small Group Book Study: Participants will then take part in a small group book study using *Anxious to Talk About it: Helping White People to Talk Faithfully About Racism (2nd edition)* by Carolyn Helsel. There will be three sessions spread over 6 weeks to allow plenty of time for people to read and reflect and process. Each study group will be facilitated by two members of the *In God's Steps* leader-ship team and will meet at three different times throughout the week. When you register, you'll indicate your preference for which group(s) you could participate in.

Closing Dinner February 25: Finally, for those who complete the book study, there will be a closing dinner where we will reflect on what we have learned and experienced and discern what God is calling us to next as individuals and as a community.

Registration is required so that we can plan adequately. You can use the <u>online form</u> or complete one of the paper forms available at the church.

ADVENT DEVOTIONS


My sister called me a few weeks ago and asked me to suggest an Advent devotional book for her. I dove into the literature and the stack of books I'd been gathering on my desk and chose two that I thought might peak her interest. If you are still casting about for a book of Advent devotions, perhaps you will consider one of these?



The first is *Advent in Plain Sight: A Devotion through Ten Objects* by Jill Duffield. This daily devotional runs through Advent, Christmas, and Epiphany. The author focuses on 10 ordinary objects that appear in the biblical narratives, objects that we encounter in our daily lives. Through objects like gates, trees, cloth, light and water, Duffield considers what divine proximity means for us and our lives. Each daily reading includes a Scripture reading, a prayer and thoughtful questions for reflection. This book will help you remember that God still dwells among us amidst the ordinary things of our life.

I love *Watch for the Light* because it has a little bit of everything and features some of my very favorite writers. This Ecumenical anthology gathers fifty devotions that invite the reader to contemplate the great themes of Christmas and the significance that the coming of Jesus has for each of us – not only during Advent, but every day. Between its covers you will find contributions from Thomas Merton, Henri Nouwen, Meister Eckhart, Karl Barth, Will Willimon and Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Also included are Madeleine L'Engle, T.S. Eliot, Sylvia Plath, John Donne, Jane Kenyon, Annie Dillard and Kathleen Norris. There is something for everyone in this wonderful anthology.


