Godly Play

Imagine a place where everyone is not just welcome, but they feel welcomed.

A place where people can gather together and feel safe, comfortable, equal. Where adults and children weigh on equal ground. Where gender, race, and social status are never factored in? A place where we all hold equal space simultaneously. Now imagine that in this place God held the center and nothing obstructed God's view of each person, or God's love for each person. Where each person had the exact view and invitation to God. I wonder what this place looks like to you? I wonder if you have ever been in a place like this? I wonder how this place makes you feel?

What I have described to you is a Godly Play space. Godly play is not a classroom. There is no right or wrong answer in a Godly Play space. Godly Play will not teach you anything. I know that is bold, so let me rephrase this, Godly Play is not here to teach you. Instead, Godly Play is a space for you to experience God through a tangible story. Experience it with your eyes, your ears, your hands, and all of your senses. Godly Play invites all participants to contemplate each biblical story told and process it with their own uniqueness. The rhythm of the story invites you to slow down and focus on the mystery of God, the mystery of the bible, and the mystery of oneself. It creates a safe space where one can accept or reject a story without consequence. It models healthy boundaries while allowing personal freedom. So Goldy Play will not teach you anything, but it will allow you to learn and grow in God's presence.

We at Laurel Heights United Methodist Church have a space devoted to Godly Play. It is in room 105 and hosts our Kinder through Second graders on Sunday mornings at 10:00am. 
