Every Sunday in Lent, we will preach about different ways that God calls for the waters of justice to roll.

Christians around the world often give up a favorite food, beverage, or activity during Lent. I wonder what prejudices or biases are we challenged to give up as a Lenten practice of abstinence? Perhaps we are called to dig a little deeper and to give of ourselves for the sake of the world. Whether you feel called to give up something or to act in a different way, we hope to see you often over the next forty days!


