They provide vocational skills training and paid employment, with diverse job opportunities and options both on and off the Ranch. They provide a community for people with and without IDD to enjoy companionship, friendships, fun, travel, recreation, and an active lifestyle.

They achieve their mission by Integrating into the surrounding local communities and the larger Austin metropolitan community, while becoming increasingly active on the national stage. They seek to be on the cutting edge in creating an entrepreneurial organization that attracts people interested in disability, horticulture, agriculture, environment, good steward-ship and more.

In 1975, a working group from Laurel Heights United Methodist Church led by, Henry Holloway, Director of Music and Adult Ministries Committee established a ministry for seniors in the church and in the City of San Antonio. Realizing the need for more organized activities for senior adults, they developed programs to meet those needs. Beginning with a small group that met for fellow-ship, worship, singing, education, fun and travel, the group grew from twenty-five active seniors to 450. As it grew, the name "Super Adults" and the motto "Make New Friends, but keep the old, one is Silver, the other Gold" were adopted, along with the logo: "Super Adults on the Go."

Now in their 50th year Super Adults are still going strong. Super Adult Day is typically, the 4th Thursday of each month, and includes Super Adult Bingo at 10:30 and lunch and a program from 11 to 12:30. Coffee, cookies and conversation are available at 10a.m. Birthdays are celebrated with cake, candles, singing of a special "Happy Birthday" song, and a prayer.
