Reflections on the Stations of the Cross

Many of you have participated in Laurel Height's 2024 Stations of the Cross and Good Friday Tenebrae service. We appreciate your attendance in these meaningful events and are grateful to share the success of them.

The stations of the cross, held Maundy Thursday and Good Friday, invited both families and individuals to reflect intentionally on the days and events leading up to Jesus's crucifixion and resurrection. Stations included a scripture reading and an activity to help further our understanding of what really happened on those days.

Participants were able to wash each other's feet in the same selfless act of service that Jesus did the night before He was betrayed.

Hammering a nail into a wooden cross reminded us of the pain inflicted on Him for the sake of us and our freedom. And painting our names on a rock encouraged us that when that stone was rolled away, He had our name in His mind.

As one astute child put it, "it's all about the love." Children and adults alike could feel the gentle yet strong love and the presence of God as we all navigated through these stations and Holy Week together as a church community. 
