2020 General Conference

Dear Church-

Some of you are probably thinking that I am most certainly mixed up when you read the headline of this piece. I am not. General Conference 2020 is about to take place from April 23-May 3 in Charlotte, NC. COVID delayed General Conference 2020 and this is the first chance the United Methodist Church has been able to hold it.

Others may be asking what General Conference is. The General Conference is the governing body of the United Methodist Church that meets every four years. This video provides a good explanation: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=U2MLEFn3b8M.

And still others may be wondering why I am writing about this meeting in our newsletter. I am writing because I anticipate you will begin seeing news stories about General Conference in the media. You may have friends who know you attend a United Methodist Church ask you what is happening. My husband texted a *US News* article to me just this morning. I did not want you to begin seeing these stories without some information.

Because the structure and polity of the UMC is designed similarly to the political and governmental systems in the United States, it is impossible to know exactly what proposals will make it through committees to the floor for a vote. In much the same way that you hear that policies in our government are stuck in a committee or are not being put forward by the Speaker of the House or the Senate Majority Leader, this can happen at General Conference as well.

Along with passing a budget, you may hear of three objectives that have support for this General Conference: **regionalization**; **revision**; and **removal** of harmful language. These three proposals have earned the name: The Three R's. **Regionalization** would enable the U.S. to amend the U.M. Book of Discipline to fit its own context, without worrying how changes might impact our sisters and brothers from around the world and in particular from Africa and the Philippines. There are a number of proposals to **revise** and update the Social Principles which are an official summary of The U.M.C.'s stated convictions on social issues of the day. And finally, there are a few proposals to **remove** from the Book of Discipline language that has been harmful to our LGBTQ+ brothers and sisters.

At this time, there is no way of knowing what proposals will make it through committee to the floor for a vote. I hope you join me in praying for all of the delegates and the Council of Bishops as they travel to Charlotte and spend multiple days in discernment, conversation, and legislation.

If you have questions, I would be happy to try to answer them. If I do not know the answer, I will find someone who does.
