General Conference 2024

It's been an incredibly long journey these past for years for the United Methodist Church and especially those of the LGBT+ community who are a part of it.

In 1972, the UMC addressed homosexuality in its Book of Discipline, saying, "homosexual persons no less than heterosexual persons are individuals of sacred worth, though we do not condone the practice of homosexuality and consider this practice incompatible with Christian doctrine."

These words, plus heavy restrictions on marrying same-sex couples within the church and forbidding LGBT+ clergy to be ordained, have remained within the denomination for over forty years and have been a source of hurt, confusion and despair for many Methodists who also identify as LGBT.

People who truly want to follow God's will for their life and desire to be a part of a community that accepts them and loves them for who they are, have been told that who they are is wrong. We are told that we have "worth" but are not shown the same respect or rights as our heterosexual peers. Clearly there was something amiss.

General conference, a meeting of the highest legislative body in the UMC, meets every four years to determine the future of the denomination. In 2020, they were scheduled to meet to discuss many things including this very issue. COVID - 19 put a pause button on that.

But here were are in 2024. General conference resumes. And on May 1st love has won. The harmful language has been removed from the Book of Discipline. Those who identify as LGBT+ are able to be ordained with their peers, and same-sex couples are now officially able to be married and recognized as such within the church.

It's been a long journey indeed, but we've stuck it out. Where biases and tradition try to keep things the "same as they've always been," God is doing a new thing. And do we not see it?

Love is breaking through the cracks, healing old wounds and inviting everyone to be a part of this beautiful community that is the United Methodist Church. It is a good day indeed.
